Schiphol Airport is known as a major passenger and freight gateway into the Netherlands and Western Europe, ranking amongst Europe's top five airports. Over 45 million passengers and 1,5 million tons of freight passed through Schiphol Airport in 2006. There are 550 companies located at Schiphol with a total of 60,000 employees.

SKIDATA Benelux B.V. has equipped more than 7 long- and short-term car parks and more than 10 staff parkings, which amounts to approx. 70% of a total of approximately 35,000 parking spaces. There are 180 shops and food & beverage outlets at the airport.

The overall car park area with its enormous capacity is the largest in the Netherlands. It is divided into various different car parks, each with its individual requirements and configurations.

There is a dedicated parking zone for VIP clients, and an additional two car parks for the hotel located at the airport. All car parks are linked to a central control- and management system that allows efficient administration.
