



Penang International Airport

Malaysia

The Penang International Airport serves as the main airport for the northern region of Malaysia. In 2013, the airport registered more than 5.48 million passengers and 60,020 aircraft movements. The Penang International Airport is the third largest airport in the country, after the international airports in Kuala Lumpur and Kota Kinabalu.

The airport in Penang is the first project of SKIDATA Malaysia which was realized for Malaysia Airports Bernard (MAB). With 25 airports across the country, MAB is the largest airport operator in Malaysia.

Due to a reorganization of the parking areas at the Kuala Lumpur airport, the SKIDATA system

installed in 2010 was no longer needed there. SKIDATA Malaysia uninstalled the equipment, carried out an extensive refurbishing and modernization, and then installed a part of the system at the airport in Penang.

A CCTV system installed by SKIDATA also ensures the control and surveillance of the entire parking facility 24 hours / 7 days a week. MAB signed a comprehensive service agreement with SKIDATA Malaysia and a local SKIDATA service technician takes care of the system in order to guarantee fast and reliable service.
