

Terms of use Intertraffic Demo App

1. General information

1.1. This demo app ("App") is provided by SKIDATA GmbH ("we", "us", "our") during the Intertraffic (the "Event").

2. Scope and nature of the demo

2.1. The App is a non-production, demonstration-only experience for the Event.

2.2. It may not function continuously or error-free and may be modified or withdrawn without notice.

2.3. Do not rely on the App for any commercial, medical, safety, or mission-critical purposes.

3. Eligibility and acceptable use

3.1. You may use the App if you are [16/18] or older, or have appropriate consent if required by local law.

3.2. You agree not to: (i) reverse engineer; (ii) interfere with security or the network; (iii) upload illegal or harmful content; (iv) infringe intellectual property or privacy rights; (v) use the App in violation of law or Event rules.

4. Information we collect and why (Privacy)

4.1. We collect the following information, which is necessary if you want to try the App :

- a) Data elements: Your name (required for sign-in).
- b) Purpose: To personalize and operate the demo, manage the demo queue/participation, and conduct basic usage analytics during the Event.
- c) Legal basis (GDPR): Consent (Art. 6(1)(a)) provided when you tap "I Agree."
- d) Retention: We keep your name only for the duration of the Event and delete it no later than 2 weeks after the Event ends.
- e) Sharing: We may share with service providers that host or support the App, under data-processing agreements (AWS Europe). We do not sell attendee data.
- f) Security: We apply reasonable technical and organizational measures appropriate to the demo's limited scope.
- g) Optional fields (remove if not used):
- h) Email (optional) to send a follow-up about the product—only with your separate opt-in consent.

5. Your privacy rights (GDPR)

5.1. Subject to law, you may access, rectify, erase, restrict, or object to processing, and withdraw consent at any time (withdrawal doesn't affect prior lawful processing). You may lodge a complaint with your supervisory authority (e.g., in Austria: Datenschutzbehörde, Barichgasse 40–42, 1030 Wien, www.dsb.gv.at).

6. Intellectual property and feedback

6.1. All content and software in the App are owned by us or our licensors. You receive a limited, revocable, non-exclusive, non-transferable right to use the App only for the demo.

6.2. If you give us feedback, you grant us a perpetual, irrevocable, worldwide, royalty-free license to use it for any purpose, without attribution or compensation.

7. No warranties

7.1. The App is provided "as is" and "as available." We disclaim all warranties to the maximum extent permitted by law, including fitness for a particular purpose and non-infringement.

8. Limitation of liability

8.1. To the fullest extent permitted by law, we are not liable for indirect, incidental, special, consequential, exemplary, or punitive damages, or any loss of profits, data, or goodwill arising out of or related to the demo. Our total liability for all claims related to the demo will not exceed EUR 100 or the minimum amount permitted by law. Your statutory rights remain unaffected.

9. Termination and suspension

9.1. We may suspend or terminate demo access at any time (e.g., misuse, security risk, or Event closure). Upon termination, your right to use the App ends immediately.

10. Changes to the demo or terms

10.1. We may update the demo or these Terms for Event operations or legal reasons. Material changes during the Event will be posted in-App or at the booth.

11. Governing law; venue

11.1. These Terms are governed by the laws of Austria excluding conflict-of-laws rules. Courts of Salzburg, Austria have exclusive jurisdiction, except where mandatory consumer protection rules provide otherwise.
